Title:	BOD-02: Conduct of Public at Board Meetings

Conservation Authority Board Meetings are open to the public to attend, with the exception of in-camera sessions, which involve discussions related to personnel, legal, property or third party matters.

The conduct of the public at Board Meetings are to adhere to this policy.

1.0 Definitions

Board of Directors: refers to the Board of Directors of the Lakehead Region Conservation Authority as appointed by the Member Municipalities of the Lakehead Region Conservation Authority.

Chair: refers to the elected Chair of the Lakehead Region Conservation Authority

Public: any person other than the media, Board of Directors or staff of the Lakehead Region Conservation Authority.

Staff: refers to any staff member employed by the Lakehead Region Conservation Authority.

2.0 Photographic, Audio or Video Recording

No member of the public shall take or attempt to take a photograph, motion picture, video recording, or other recording capable of producing visual or aural representations by electronic means, or otherwise, at any proceedings of the Board otherwise open to the public.

3.0 Addressing the Board

Except for the submission of briefs or deputations, at no time during the proceedings may members of the public address or participate in discussion at the Board Meetings.

Persons wishing to present a brief or deputation to the Board must adhere to the Lakehead Region Conservation Authority Deputation Policy.
