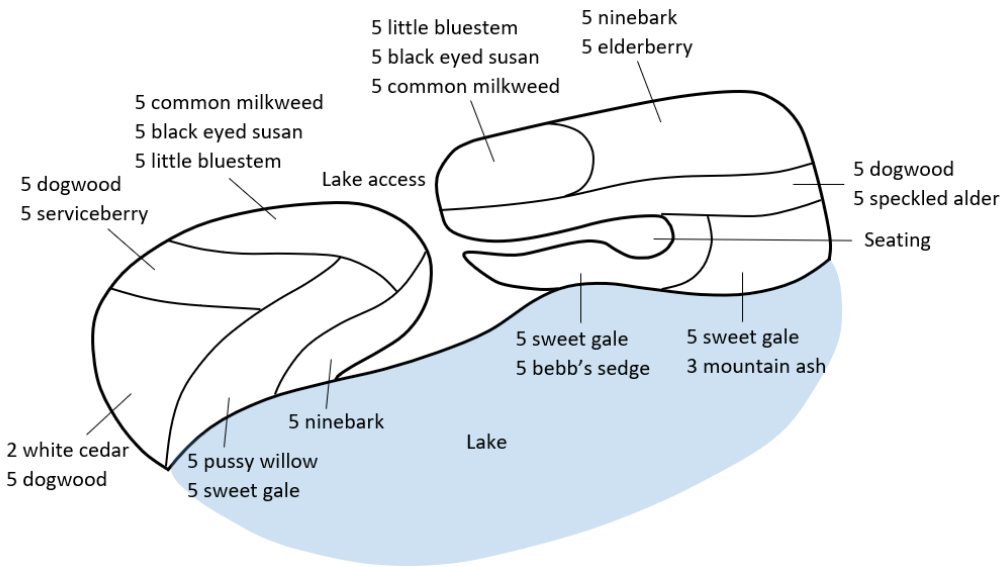


## LAKEFRONT SHORELINE Sample Planting Plan

This sample planting plan consists of 18 metres of shoreline with 2 trees, 63 shrubs, and 35 perennials. The plan includes lake access, with plantings on either side covering approximately 100 square metres.

The design incorporates an area within the vegetation for seating, with low-lying shrubs and grasses in front of the seating to maintain the lakeview. A lake access point of approximately 5 metres has been maintained.

3	Mountain ash ( <i>Sorbus decora</i> )	shrub	4-9
10	Ninebark ( <i>Physocarpus opulifolius</i> )	shrub	2-3
5	Pussy willow ( <i>Salix discolor</i> )	shrub	2-6
15	Red osier dogwood ( <i>Cornus stolonifera</i> )	shrub	1.5-3
5	Serviceberry ( <i>Amelanchier alnifolia</i> )	shrub	2-7
5	Speckled alder ( <i>Alnus incarna</i> )	shrub	3-6
15	Sweet gale ( <i>Myrica gale</i> )	shrub	0.5-1.5
2	White cedar ( <i>Thuja occidentalis</i> )	tree	15-30
