


Did you know that you can make a big difference in keeping water clean and helping to conserve water? By not littering and being careful about how much water you use, you can help to protect our water supply.

How to make your waterpicks game



Lay the square face down on a flat surface, fold all 4 corners of the sheet into the centre. forming a smaller square.





Flip the smaller sqaure over and fold all 4 corners into the center again.







Then, fold it half one way, open, then fold in half the other way. Then stick your two thumbs and two forefingers into each of the 4 flap pockets. Fingers should press centre creases so that all 4 flaps meet at a point in the center.

How to play your waterpicks game

Ask someone to pick a type of water area from one of the four flaps, marsh, lake, stream, river. Open and close the game, first in one direction then the other equal to the number of letters in the word they select (e.g. 4 for lake).

Ask the player to select one of the 4 visible numbers, open and close the game again that number of times.

Ask the player to select one more number, then open the flap to reveal a watershed character.
