Fantastic hiking at Wishart

Wishart Forest is a 221 hectare spruce and jack pine, boreal forest. In summer, a green carpet of moss gives the area a northern appeal. In winter, make your tracks over the rolling topography of Wishart by snowshoes. The trail explores the hills of Wishart.



DIRECTIONS:
Turn onto Wardrope Avenue (off of Balsam Street), then make a right onto Onion Lake Road. Follow Onion Lake Road north for about 10.4 km. Wishart Forest will be on the left.

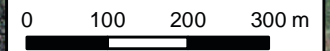
