*Please note that in accordance with Ontario Regulation 41/24: Prohibited Activities, Exemptions and Permits under the Conservation Authorities Act, you may require a permit from the Lakehead Region Conservation Authority. Development within the Approximate Regulated Area may require a Permit from the Authority to confirm that the control of flooding, erosion or dynamic beaches are not affected. The straightening, changing, diverting, or interfering in any way with the existing channel of a river, creek, stream, watercourse, lake shoreline or changing or interfering in any way with a wetland will also require a Permit.*

*Regulated activities within the Approximate Regulated Area include construction, reconstruction, erection, or placing of a structure of any kind; any change to a building or structure such as increasing the size; the temporary or permanent placing, dumping, or removal of any material, originating on the site or elsewhere; site grading; or any alteration to a watercourse including culvert, bridge, and boat launch installation, repairs, or replacements.*
